

Travel directions to Bintry Mill Trout Fishery New Signing-in Box

From East Dereham

Leave Dereham on the B1110, heading north, towards North Elmham. Go through the village and turn right at the brown tourist sign for County School Station. The new signing-in box is in the meadow on the upstream side of the bridge. Please park by the former County School station.

From King's Lynn

There are two possible routes:

- 1. King's Lynn by-pass, A149, at the roundabout by the Queen Elizabeth Hospital take the third exit for the B1145 and follow it to North Elmham. At the junction by the King's Head Hotel, turn left and go through the village. Then follow directions above.
- 2. King's Lynn by-pass, A149, at the roundabout by the Knight's Hill Hotel and Spa take the third exit for the A148 to Fakenham and Norwich. Take Fakenham by-pass and keep heading towards Norwich. Approaching Guist take the right fork coming into the village after the flashing speed limit sign, and turn to the right again immediately. Follow this road over the river Wensum, past the left turn to Bintry Mill. Continue towards North Elmham until you see the brown tourist sign for County School Station. Turn left here and the new signing-in box is in the meadow on the upstream side of the bridge.

From Norwich

Take the Norwich-Fakenham road, A 1067, towards Fakenham. In the village of Guist turn left by the clock tower. Follow directions above.

DAY TICKET RULES For the Yarrow Farm and County School Beats

- 1. Please sign-in at the signing-in box by County School Bridge, by completing *Part 1* of a catch return card (one card for each beat), before fishing. Before departure, please complete *Part 2* of the same card or cards.
- 2. The upper end of the Yarrow Farm beat is marked by a white post and a sign on the true left-hand bank. The lower end of the County School beat is marked by a white post on the true right-hand bank. No access is allowed on banks marked in red on the map.
- 3. Cars can be parked in the parking area by the former County School station or by Yarrow Bridge, on the true right-hand bank.
- 4. No dogs nor swimming allowed. Please shut gates after passing through and remove all litter.
- 5. The permitted methods are dry fly and upstream nymph only. Barbless or de-barbed hooks only. NO wet fly fishing or wet flies to be used. Fishing is allowed until one hour after sunset.
- 6. All wild fish and untagged fish are to be returned with care and handled with wet hands only. Only stock fish which are marked with a nylon tag by the dorsal fin may be killed. Please record the colour of the tag. The takeable catch limit for tagged trout is one brace.
- 7. Visitors must treat the Fishery and river with respect. Do not flatten the bankside vegetation. DO NOT break off branches or destroy young trees on the banks.
